- At all times material hereto, the Defendant, SIMON, owned, operated, controlled, managed and/or maintained a mall known as TOWN CENTER at BOCA RATON located in Boca Raton, Florida.
- On or about August 7, 2007 the Plaintiff, JANE DOE, was violently abducted while on the Defendant's property in Boca Raton, Florida.

NEGLIGENCE-LACK OF SECURITY AGAINST SIMON PROPERTY GROUP

Plaintiff restates and realleges paragraphs 1 through 5 as if fully set forth herein and further state:

- At all times material hereto, the Defendant, SIMON, owned, operated, controlled, managed and/or maintained the premises located at TOWN CENTER AT BOCA RATON in Boca Raton, Florida
 - Plaintiff, JANE DOE was lawfully on the premises at all times.
- At said time and place, the Defendant, SIMON, by and through its agents, servants and/or employees, carelessly and negligently maintained the said premises by not providing adequate security measures for business invitees, including, but not limited to, Plaintiff, JANE DOE.
- As a result of the lack of security provided by the Defendant, the Plaintiff,
 JANE DOE, was left unprotected when approached and was violently abducted by an unknown assailant.
- 10. At all times material hereto, the Defendant, SIMON, by and through its agents, servants, and/or employees, had a duty to maintain and control its premises in a safe and careful manner.
